Knowing the demands placed on student dancers, the Richmond Virtual School has started an online high school credit program for any dancer who completes 100 hours of dance over the course of one school year and is currently in a BC high school grades 9-12.

The following courses are available for the 2019/20 school year and count for fine arts credits and elective credits:
Dance 10, 11, 12 Technique & Performance
Dance 10, 11, 12 Choreography
(Grade 9 students can enroll in Dance 10)

Program Details

This program is for all dancers who dance a minimum of 100 hours over the course of a school year. If they dance 200+ hours they qualify to take two courses. They are required to complete online weekly journal entries, and a series of 3 assignments each term. (There are 3 terms in total). These assignments consist of reflections, self/teacher evaluations, a dance performance assignment and a few more. These credits count for their mandatory Fine Arts/Applied Skills graduation requirements according to the ministry of education.
