Program Details

This program is for all dancers who dance a minimum of 100 hours over the course of a school year. If they dance 200+ hours they qualify to take two courses. They are required to complete online weekly journal entries, and a series of 3 assignments each term (there are 3 terms in total). These assignments consist of reflections, self/teacher evaluations, a dance performance assignment and a few more. These credits count for their mandatory Fine Arts/Applied Skills graduation requirements required by the Ministry of Education.
